Did you know...

- Two-thirds of this world can't, don't or won't read
- 4 billion people are largely shut out from a presentation of the Gospel using literate means
- 75% of our Bible is narrative, 15% is poetry/song and 10% is letters
- Jesus, according to Mark chap 4, never taught anything except through the medium of a parable (story)
- 90% of all Christian ministry occurs in literate styles
- If most of our world receives and processes information through non-literate (oral) means, why do we continue to predominantly use literate forms of outreach to reach them?
- How would Jesus teach today?

Our story

The story4all vision came into being in the Spring of 2005. As missionaries communicating with prayer supporters on another continent during a stressful time in our lives, we, Bryan and Amarilis Thompson, began experimenting with the new technology called "podcasting". We saw the power of communicating regularly to a committed subscriber base through this means.

Spanning almost three decades of ministry experience in a number of countries around the world we have seen the power of ministering through the use of stories. Whether it was reaching out to Muslims with a story about Abraham's call to sacrifice Isaac or telling a story in a seminar to Haitian pastors, the Lord seemed to come with His presence and, in the case of the pastors, in healing power. The tales about evangelism and discipling others through the use of Bible narrative are many, but that is another story for another time!

Since early 2004 we have been in fellowship with a growing network of believers worldwide who believe that a huge change must come if

we are to see the unreached reached and churches multiplied among them.

We believe it is time to make disciples of oral learners through oral means of communication – stories, drama, song, etc.

The story4all ministry was founded out of a desire to inform and resource the Body of Christ with materials and tools that promote and encourage the use of oral strategies to reach oral peoples.

Since most of today's unreached have to, or prefer to, receive information via non-literate means, and, if church planting movements are to happen among them, we believe it is essential that we communicate with them in a style and language that they understand.

To this end we have launched the story4all podcast with a weekly show that will bring you news, interviews, discussion, reviews and links to resources that will help you discover the power of "storying", as well as bring you stories and testimonies about how God is using stories to bring in a great harvest worldwide among unreached peoples and also in Western nations.
